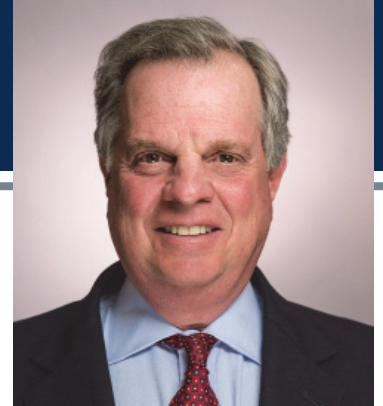


Management Committee
